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Next Town Board Meeting on solar projects is April 26 at 7 PM
at the Neptune Fire Hall at 26 North Street

On March 16th the Town Board opened a public hearing to hear public comment on and review the application of SUN8 PDC, LLC (c/o Distributed Sun, LLC) for community solar projects at 2150 Dryden, Stevenson, Dodge and Turkey Hill Roads. This Special Use Permit application is for the installation of 29 MW of large-scale community solar energy systems distributed across the four locations listed above. In response to a number of concerns and issues that were raised at that meeting the applicant has revised their application. The Town Board's public hearing on this application will resume at a special meeting on April 26 at 7 PM at Neptune Fire Hall at 26 North Street in the Village of Dryden. Subsequent meetings will be held by both the Planning Board and Town Board to review the site plan and other aspects of the Special Use Permit application.

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
