

Town of Dryden

Resolution # _____ of 2016, dated January 21, 2016

Whereas, the Town Board is responsible for appointing residents to the Planning Board, Conservation Board, Zoning Board of Appeals, Dryden Recreation and Youth Commission, and the Agricultural Advisory Board (hereinafter Advisory Boards), the purpose of which is to assist the Town Board in making decisions affecting the Town of Dryden; and

Whereas, the Town Board recognizes that because the Advisory Boards have membership numbers established by law or resolution there are limited opportunities for residents to participate as voting members and alternates on said Advisory Boards; and

Whereas, the Town Board wishes to include as many residents as possible in the membership of said Advisory Boards; and

Whereas, the Town Board recognizes that permitting a single individual to sit as a voting member or alternate on more than one Advisory Board limits the opportunities for residents to participate as voting members and alternates; and

Whereas, limiting residents to one appointment as a voting member or alternate on the Town's Advisory Boards will create opportunities for more residents to participate in Town Government; and

Whereas, creating opportunities for greater participation in Town Government is in the best interests of the Town of Dryden.

Therefore, it is hereby resolved by the Town Board of the Town of Dryden that no person shall hold more than one Advisory Board appointment as a voting member or alternate at any one time.

It is further resolved by the Town Board of the Town of Dryden that no person shall be appointed as a voting member to more than two consecutive terms to any Advisory Board.
