RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE FUEL TRACKING SYSTEM

Whereas the Town Highway Department tracks fuel dispensed from the storage tank by vehicle; and

Whereas the Town also dispenses fuel to Village of Freeville, W.B. Strong, Neptune Hose Co, Dryden Ambulance Co; and

Whereas the current GasBoy system is approximately 25 years old, uses an antiquated DOS operating system; and

Whereas NYSDEC demands accurate accounting of amount of fuel deposited in the tank and amount of fuel dispensed to assure no fuel is leaking into the ground ; and

Whereas the current system is not operating with such precision,

Be it hereby resolved, that the Highway Superintendent be authorized to purchase an updated fuel system from Cortland Pump and Equipment, Inc. with a cost not to exceed \$12,000.
