I also agree and think Craig has done a great job in pointing out the numerous ways in which such an installation and creek-bank clearing is antithetical to the preservation stance of previously passed, agreed-on policies. As most of us appreciate, it costs a great deal more to undo damage to creeks, watersheds, flood protection zones and agriculturally valuable land than it would to avoid the damage in the first place. As pointed out by Nancy in this case, it is not clear how much damage any alternate plans will also leave. But there should at least be detailed comparable plans to look at, before shooting trees and baring the stream to the drought....so to speak.
