

**Resolution and recommendations to the Town Board of the Town of Dryden
from the Conservation Board on the proposed SUP for the interconnections for
the 2150 Dryden Road Solar Project**

WHEREAS: The proposed project is in the sensitive area of Virgil Creek (a NYSDEC protected trout stream) and in the associated 100 year flood plain, and

WHEREAS: The developer has provided documentation of NYSDEC approval for clear cutting areas along Virgil Creek and has provided an erosion or sediment control plan for the same area, assuring that the pole installation will meet NYSDEC requirements including no removal of stumps including in the riparian buffer, and

WHEREAS: The Planning Board has reviewed the above referenced project with public input, and

WHEREAS: The Planning Board has made seven specific recommendations to the Town Board, and

WHEREAS: The Conservation Board agrees with those seven recommendations, putting special weight on number one, i.e.:

“The Planning Board recommends the Town Board push back on the developer and require the NYSEG interconnect be accomplished with pad mounted equipment and underground lines”.

Therefore be it resolved: The Conservation Board supports the seven recommendations made to the Town Board from the Planning Board and puts strong emphasis on the first point.
