Mr. Burger,

As a follow-up to our phone conversation this afternoon, NYS Department of Transportation is finalizing the safety study at the Route 366 and Freese Road intersection. That review included an analysis of a six-year crash history, signal warrant analysis, review of traffic volumes, and the onsite conditions.

Based on our review, NYSDOT engineers determined that a three-color signal is not warranted at this time. However, we did determine that an overhead flashing signal at the intersection is appropriate at this time. We've started the process on getting this design work incorporated in a future project, but it's not known at this time when this signal work can be constructed at this time.

In the short term, we will also be improving the warning signs on Route 366 to enhance safety and to increase motorist's awareness in advance of the Route 366 and Freese Road intersection. The sign improvements will be completed by NYSDOT maintenance crews once the materials are procured and the work scheduled.
