Hi Jason,

I'm writing to request an adjustment of my sewer bill, account no. L5266, due 10/20/20. Here's the situation: I have a very large garden. I'm retired, that's what I do.

When the drought hit, I began to water heavily, and expected a much increased water bill. It was more than double, but I am happy to pay it, and that the water was available. But what surprised me was the dramatic increase in the sewer bill as well. When I called Bolton Point, they explained that the County assumes that the water that goes out from their system goes into the sewer lines. In my case, the water went into the ground and into the roots of trees and shrubs, and not into the County sewer lines.

I am requesting that my sewer bill be adjusted to its normal amount. At the last bill, it was \$57.60. This current amount due is \$124.80.
