The Agricultural Advisory Committee was established in 2013 to advise the Dryden Town Board on issues related to Agriculture and Agriculture related activities. The Ag Committee meets the 2nd Wednesday of each month at 7:30PM.

The Conservation Board assists and advises in the creation and implementation of plans and policies related to environmental protection and management, open space, natural areas, and agriculture. The Board meets at 7:00PM on the last Tuesday of the month.
