

At a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Dryden, Tompkins County, New York, held on April 22, 2021, the following resolution was offered by _____, who moved its adoption, seconded by _____:

RESOLUTION SCHEDULING A PUBLIC HEARING
REGARDING IMPROVEMENT OF THE TOWN OF
DRYDEN CONSOLIDATED SEWER DISTRICT
FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Dryden (the "Town") proposes to undertake the acquisition, construction and installation of improvements to the Town of Dryden Consolidated Sewer District sanitary sewer system including, but not limited to, the replacement or rehabilitation of sewer mains, manholes, pump stations and other facilities, and the acquisition of machinery, equipment or apparatus required in connection therewith, at a maximum estimated cost of \$5,358,570; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board now desires to call a public hearing regarding the acquisition, construction and installation of the Town of Dryden Consolidated Sewer District improvements, as required by Town Law Section 202-b;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Board will hold a public hearing to hear all persons interested in the improvement of the Town of Dryden Consolidated Sewer District facilities, which public hearing shall be held at _____, in the Town of Dryden on May 20, 2021 at _____ p.m.; and be it further

RESOLVED, and ordered that the Town Clerk give notice of such hearing by publishing in the official Town newspaper the Notice of Public Hearing in substantially the form attached hereto and by posting the Notice of Public Hearing on the Town's official sign-board not less than ten nor more than twenty days before such hearing.
