Dear Mr. Burger:

On behalf of Dominion Energy Transmission, Inc. (DETI), please find attached hereto revised Site Development Plans and a revised Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). Both of these documents have been revised to reflect a reduction in the size of the temporary work area south of Ellis Hollow Creek Road, such that no work is being proposed within 50 feet of a NYSDEC Freshwater Wetland. Essentially the limits of disturbance (LOD) for the project have been reduced to conform with the requirements of the NYSDEC General Permit for work in the Adjacent Area of a Freshwater Wetland (GP-0-18-001).

Changes to the Site Development Plans include a reduction in the size of the temporary work area south of Ellis Hollow Road.

Changes to the SWPPP only involve revisions related to the limits of disturbance (LOD) change. These changes include callouts of the LOD area in Section 1.3 of the SWPPP, and in Part 4 of the NOI. No other portions of the SWPPP main text or appendices have been changed.
