

Resolution #____ (2022) Approve Replacement of Town Hall Light Fixtures

Whereas, the Highway garage and office building were changed to LED lights in 2019, but proper sized lights for Town Hall were not available at the time.

Whereas, the Highway Superintendent has received a quote for replacing the Town Hall lights and fixtures with energy efficient LED lights.

Whereas, it is projected that the new lights will decrease the Town Hall's annual energy usage by 17,299 kWh, which is estimated to save the Town \$2,267.21 in energy costs.

Therefore, be it resolved that the Board approves the purchase of new LED lights and fixtures for the Town Hall for \$20,496.62.
