

TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF DRYDEN
RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF HIGHWAYS

Resolution No. __ - 2022

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2010 the Town of Dryden Planning Board granted to Bernard and Sandra Cornelius subdivision approval for a subdivision to be known as Manhattan Estates Phase I; and

Whereas, the final plan for said subdivision was filed in the Office of the Tompkins County Clerk on July 7, 2020, together with approval of the Tompkins County Health Department for said subdivision; and

Whereas, said subdivision approval provided for dedication to the Town of two roads to be known as Twister Way and Phantom Drive; and

Whereas both Twister Way and Phantom Drive have been constructed and maintained by Cornelius, each with a standard 60-foot right of way to the standard for town roads effective at the time of their construction; and

Whereas, said Twister Way and Phantom Drive have been inspected by the Town Superintendent of Highways, Mr. Richard Young, Jr., and pronounced by him to be in satisfactory condition and suitable for use as town highways; and

Whereas, Cornelius have requested that the Town accept the dedication to the Town as town highways the said Twister Way and Phantom Drive,

Now, therefore, it is hereby

Resolved, that the Town upon the presentation to the Town of a deed in good form as approved by the attorney for the Town, accept as Town highways said Twister Way and Phantom Drive; and it is further

Resolved, that the Town Supervisor is authorized to execute and deliver as the act of the Town such documents as may be required to give effect to this Resolution.
