

Mr. Skaley,

I have recently been appointed Design Engineer for the region and wanted to take a minute to introduce myself and also get back to you on your questions.

Our Traffic Safety and Mobility group reviewed the radar speed sign request and the crosswalk locations and determined that they were not warranted for inclusion in the project.

Additionally, the Department does not generally install radar speed signs nor should they be installed in a permanent locations as they lose their effectiveness.

While these features are not included in the contract work, that does not preclude the Town of Dryden from pursuing their installation by applying for a Highway Work Permit from the Department.

As far as expected construction schedule: The project has yet to be awarded so we can't be sure of the start of work at this time, but following the usual timeline we could expect construction to begin around June.
