Notice of Public Hearing
Town of Dryden

The Town of Dryden will hold a public hearing on May 18 at 6:00 pm at Dryden Town Hall; 93 E. Main Street; Dryden, NY 13053 for the purpose of hearing public comments on the Town of Dryden's community development needs, and to discuss the possible submission of one or more Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) applications for the 2023 program year. The CDBG program is administered by the New York State Office of Community Renewal (OCR), and will make available to eligible local governments up to approximately \$1,250,000 for the 2023 program year for housing, economic development, public facilities, public infrastructure, and planning activities, with the principal purpose of benefitting low/moderate income persons. The Town of Dryden is applying for up to \$1,000,000 in CDBG funds to assist Central New York Manufactured Home Community (CNYMHC) for critical wastewater system improvements. The hearing will provide further information about the CDBG program and will allow for citizen participation in the development of any proposed grant applications and/or to provide technical assistance to develop alternate proposals. Comments on the CDBG program or proposed project(s) will be received at this time. The hearing is being conducted pursuant to Section 570.486, Subpart I of the CFR and in compliance with the requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.

The Dryden Town Hall is accessible to persons with disabilities.
