Recreation

The county administrator froze funding for an open position in the department. It is currently on the cut list, but they put in an Over Target Request to restore funding.

Town Board

Approved resolution to apply for Design Connect grant. The deadline is 7/31 so we may not be able to get the application together in time.

Ray Burger has started the wetlands delineation that will help us know what areas of the property we can develop for the fields/park project. It will also help ameliorate concerns from the Conservation Board.

Recreation Fields

We discussed where we're at with the field project.

Marty shared about the Cortland Standard article that mischaracterization of some background details of the fields project.

Once we have the wetlands delineation from Planning, we can move forward on roughing out a space for an initial multi-use field and begin working on larger plans.

Rick Young has ideas about parking/driveway, and electric and water access.

Leslie brought up the question of walkability.

I think there is potential to link a walking path/boardwalk from Neptune Drive.

Marty also mentioned the ongoing effect to make a trail from TC3 down to the village. We might be able to combine with or connect to that path.

I suggested tying into the location's history as the county fairgrounds to promote the project.
