## Town of Dryden Municipal Supporting Resolution for the Village of Dryden NYS DOT TAP Grant

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Dryden Town Board (hereinafter referred to as Town Board) supports the submission of the Village of Dryden's 2023 New York State Department of Transportation (NYS DOT) Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) Grant Program under the Safe Routes to School category; and

**WHEREAS,** the NYS DOT TAP Safe Routes to School Grant program provides assistance for local governments to implement an approach to increase safety and accessibility for children who currently walk or bicycle to school and ensure safe routes to school; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** the Town Board does hereby authorize and obligates local matching funds of the minimum 20% of the Town's total of any grant funding awarded hereby appropriated from the Town of Dryden Fund; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Town of Dryden recognizes and fully supports the Village's submission of the 2023 NYS DOT TAP grant application.
